Professional Status Exemptions to the NOS Standards under the APEL Protocols

Professional Bodies

The APEL process recognises both qualifications and experience and being a member of a Professional Body underpins it.

Being a Member of a Professional Body means that you have undertaken a significant application and interview process and your seniority has not only been recognised but also tested and audited by your peers.

A professional membership already establishes that the energy professional has satisfied a number of professional key requirements such as the following:

- Health & Safety in the work place through knowledge and understanding
- Competent enforcement of H&S procedures in the work place
- Capacity and capability to carry out work practices in compliance with legal requirements
- Ability to follow emergency procedures with regard to H&S
- Undertake H&S risk assessments
- Management of other workers and maintaining high professional standards at all times
- Maintaining good professional relationships with clients, management, workers and other professionals
- Encouraging a continuous professional development within the work place and within own professional institute
- Managing and resolving disputes in a professional manner
- Presenting a positive and a professional image at all times

It is recognised that Professional Membership; Chartered or Fellow status satisfies some National Occupational Standards (NOS) required under the Energy Assessors APEL route. Therefore with regard to the APEL route for the Energy Assessor, competency mapping matrix unit 1, Elements 1.1, 1.2, and 1.3 is satisfied.
